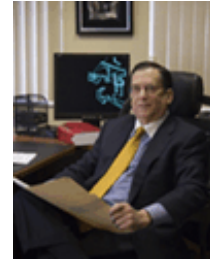
Other active areas of practice include probate and estate matters, bankruptcy, and personal injury litigation.
